We are currently in the midst of our final fundraising push to finish the Station Theatre. We need to raise approximately \$100,000 to open the doors to the public for performances. There will still be some work to complete after that, but \$100,000 will make our Theatre operational. So far, people have donated over \$14,000 with a number of individuals donating after seeing the article in the newspaper that described our fundraising campaign. There will be a plaque in the lobby mezzanine recognizing all of our donors. Those who donate will get a tax receipt. We are also planning a large "garage sale" in the spring at the Station, so if anyone has articles to donate we would be happy to accept them. We need to recognize the continuing outstanding effort that Nancy Yunker, our Fundraising Chairperson, puts into this project. Without her leadership, we would not be able to make this happen!
