Your Audition

For the audition we will be asking all auditioners to do some scales, for example DO, RE, ME, FA, SO, LA, TI, DO so we can determine your vocal range. This is because certain songs often require a certain vocal range for the singer to be able to hit the required notes. We want to make sure everyone is comfortable singing.

Please know that if you really want to be in the show but are worried about your singing ability, please don't let that prevent you from auditioning. We believe everyone can sing, and our vocal coaches are amazing, but it is important to know that everyone in the show needs to be comfortable singing at the very least, in a group.

Also, there will be lots of dancing, yes LOTS of dancing so please indicate if you have dance experience: Yes No
But again, even if you don't have experience, it will not prevent you from being cast.

During that time, we do our best to determine what role is best for you so don't be shy and come prepared to have some fun!

Now do not worry if you have never auditioned before, the fact that you wish to be in a show is terrific, just do your best to stay as relaxed as possible!
